What To Do In The Event Of An Accident.

Stop at the scene of the accident.

- Stop and inform the Gardai if any injuries have occurred as soon as possible.
- Do not attempt to move seriously injured parties.
- Inform other traffic and summon assistance if required.

Do not admit liability.

• Regardless of who is to blame, do not admit liability. If you do so, you may invalidate your insurance.

Record driver and car details.

• Using the space provided overleaf, record driver's name, address, phone number, insurance details, vehicle details and extent of vehicle damage.

Record witness details.

• Obtain witness details, using the space provided, promptly as they may leave the scene of the accident.

Record the accident details.

• Record details of time, date and location of the accident, as well as traffic flow situation, weather and visibility etc.

Make a sketch map of the scene.

- Make a sketch map of road layout, vehicle positions, approximate speeds and positions of witnesses.
- Take photographs if possible.
